- 3. Assist in lining up guest speakers for the club meetings.
- 4. Assist the students in the execution of their service projects.
- 5. Work with The Show Hope Student Initiative to further develop The Movement Club.

It is expected that the student president run each club meeting and will therefore determine the emphasis of each meeting. At TheMovementClub.org we offer a list of suggested club content as well as a sample meeting agenda for students to follow if they desire. From this site each club will choose which service project they'd like to take on at the beginning of each semester. If the club desires to take on a different project they must fill out the "new project application" form found on the site as well.
